

## **Fertile City Council Minutes July 12, 2010**

The Fertile City Council held its regular meeting at 6:30 p.m. Monday, July 12, 2010 at the Community Center. Present were: Mayor Brian Nephew and Council members Patricia Thorson and Dennis Hasler. Council members Todd Wise and Dan Gisvold were absent.

Barry Robertson, Fair Meadow Nursing Home Administrator, reported that Fair Meadow had begun the month of June with 47 residents and ended with 48. The nursing home also served 357 home delivered meals and provided 44 days of adult day care. There was also some discussion of getting the appraisal for Summerfield Apartments and of problems with State funding.

Upon review of the minutes of the previous meeting, Council member Thorson, seconded by Council member Hasler, moved that they be approved. The motion was carried.

Upon report of the Treasurer's Report and Bills, Council member Thorson, seconded by Council member Hasler, moved that they be approved. The motion was carried.

Council member Hasler then brought up that the four-wheelers and motorcycles are causing problems in areas of the community with their noise and speed and that small children can be seen driving them. The facts that these vehicles must stay under 10 m.p.h. and only be used for going to and from trail areas were discussed. It was stated that the City has complaint forms that can be used and forwarded to the County.

At 7:00 p.m. the meeting was suspended for the Public Hearing on the issuance of a Conditional Use Permit for Catherine Larson to operate a single chair salon in her home at 203 S. Mill Street. After receiving no comments, the hearing was closed and the meeting reconvened.

At this time, Council member Thorson, seconded by Council member Hasler, moved to approve the CUP for Catherine Larson. The motion carried.

Then the new zoning map was reviewed showing those parcels in the community designated as "public", as requested by the Sheriff's Department to aid them in enforcement. Council member Hasler, seconded by Council member Thorson, moved to approve the map. The motion carried.

Upon review, Council member Thorson, seconded by Council member Hasler, moved to approve Resolution 7-1-10 calling for City financial to work with MnDOT on crack filling, beacon and VASI light repair at the airport. The motion carried.

There was also discussion of the potential for Frisbee Golf to be located at the Nature Center. The Council expressed interest in the project.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
