

Fertile City Council Minutes October 11, 2010

The Fertile City Council held its last regular meeting on Monday, October 11 at the Community Center. Present were: Mayor Brian Nephew, and Council members Trish Thorson, Dennis Hasler and Dan Gisvold. Todd Wise was absent.

The meeting began with Administrator Barry Robertson's report on Fair Meadow Nursing Home. Fair Meadow began and ended September with 49 residents. The facility also served 328 home-delivered meals and provided 29 days of adult day care.

Libby Eid reported on volunteer activity at the Agassiz Environmental Learning Center.

Council member Dennis Hasler and Mayor Brian Nephew reported complaints about loud noise from a band playing at Oliver's Bar and Grill. There was discussion of Code coverage of such events and that if it is particularly aggravating they should call and ask if the music could be turned down. There was discussion, if the problem continued, of considering the possibility of looking at liquor license issuance.

After review of the September 13th meeting minutes, Council member Thorson, seconded by Council member Gisvold, moved that they be approved. The motion carried.

After review of the Treasurer's Report and the Bills, Council member Gisvold, seconded by Council member Hasler, moved that they be approved. The motion carried.

After discussion on the HRA/EDA vacancy, Council member Gisvold, seconded by Council member Thorson, moved to appoint Reid Jensrud to a five year term. The motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
